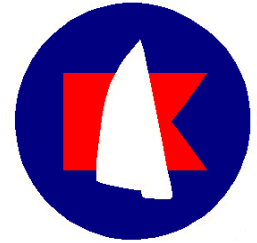


JUNIOR TRAINING ENROLMENT 2016

- *Coaching by RYA instructors and race coaches.*
- *Participants must be at least 8 years old, confident swimmers and have sufficient balance to stand up and move around while afloat.*
- *Participants are expected to take part in at least 12 club races to qualify for subsequent courses.*
- *A guardian is required at the club during the training sessions and whilst your children are at the club.*



There are three groups:

- **Beginners:** For those who are new to sailing or who have sailed a few times and want to build their confidence and basic boat handling skills (RYA level 1-2 by the end of the course). We encourage sailors in this group to get involved in the club races to practice their new skills, coaches will advise when we feel the conditions are not suitable for the children to continue practicing. Oppie/Topper boat hire is included as part of the fee as we find these are the best boats for absolute beginners in most conditions
- **Progressors:** For children who can sail a triangular course confidently (including sailing upwind and gybing) and who wish to develop more advanced boat handling skills (RYA level 3-4 by the end of the course). Attendees are also expected to practice outside of the training sessions by taking part in the junior racing. Boats may be hired if there are spare beginner boats. Children in this group should be looking at buying their own boat to sail, advice can be provided on this from any of the coaching team on buying second hand boats.
- **Racers group:** For competent sailors who want to learn how to control their boat in all winds and progress to racing. Training sessions are followed by participation in at least the first race on Sunday morning. You are expected to join in other club racing too – on Saturday and Sunday afternoons and Wednesday evening

Regardless of whether sustained by members, their guests or visitors, or caused by members, guests or visitors, whether or not such damage or injury could have been attributed or was occasioned by the neglect, default or negligence of any officials, committee members or servants of the club. Parents and guardians have the sole responsibility for their children and wards and must appreciate that the club does not exercise supervision or control.

The above children are my dependents and I accept the paragraph above, which excludes my, and my dependents, rights to claim compensation in certain circumstances. I declare that during this event the boat/s above will have valid 3rd party insurance to £2m. During the time my dependents or wards are at the club, I shall remain on the club premises or arrange appropriate supervision. I confirm that my dependents/wards are capable swimmers and are competent to take part in the event. Coaches reserve the right to exclude children exhibiting inappropriate or dangerous behavior from the coaching sessions. If appropriate the coach may require others to sail your boat, or ask your child to sail with others in other boats to learn certain skills.

When hiring a club boat it is for the day, any breakages must be paid for by the hirer or in the case of serious damage the hirer must cover the insurance policy excess. The places for the beginner and progressor groups are in high demand and we have to turn away lots of people every year, by requesting a place you are committing to attend all the coached sessions. You are also committing to supporting your child in practicing their skills either after lessons or on another evening or day the same week.

Boats can be hired at a cost of £6 per lesson subject to availability (£72 for twelve sessions) with payment in advance to reserve the boat. Please send two cheques (one for tuition and one for boat hire) if a child in the Progressors or Racer group would like to request boat hire.

Children on the beginners course will have priority over the available boats which will be allocated by the instructors.
